(3) "Teen dating violence" means:

7 (a) A pattern of behavior in which a person uses or threatens to use physical, mental or
8 emotional abuse to control another person who is in a dating relationship with the person,
9 where one or both persons are 13 to 19 years of age; or
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11 (b) Behavior by which a person uses or threatens to use sexual violence against another
12 person who is in a dating relationship with the person, where one or both persons are 13 to
13 19 years of age.

16 14 453 There is established in the State Treasury separate and distinct from the General Fund
17 the Oregon Domestic and Sexual Violence Services Fund All moneys in the fund are continuously
