



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPERTY TAX MEASURE

The Board of Directors of Portland Public Schools has placed a property tax measure, Ballot Measure 26-215, “Bonds to Improve Health, Safety, Learning by Modernizing, Repairing Schools,” on the November 3, 2020 General Election ballot.

The Multnomah County Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on this measure on September 22 at 5:00 pm. It will be held virtually in conformance with the provisions of HB 4212, passed by the Oregon Legislature during the First Special Session of 2020.
