We are pleased that Portland Public Schoolswill be offering Outdoor Schools an option for all of our sixth gradestudents across the district this school year, carrying on a tradition of more than 50 years.

The program is run by the Multnoman Education Service District (MESD) and offered during the fall and spring each school year.

In the past, the state hasnot provided any funding to support the Outdoor School Program. In November 2016, Oregonvoters approved Measure 99 to create the Outdoor School Education Fund, a dedicated fund out of the Oregon State Lottery.

While the legislaturedid not fully fund the program, the investment that the state did make to fund the programat approximately 50% will allow PPS o waive the \$85 fee that it has been traditionally charged to cover associated outstook the program such as transportation and substitute teachers.

We hope that waiving this fee will help make this program truly accessible or all students and help fulfill the intent of voters to allow "Every Oregon student in the fifth or sixth
