Limitations and Prohibitions on Use of Buildings and F acilities

The following uses are strictly prohibited in PPS buildings and on PPS grounds:

(1) Solicitation for Funds.

- (a) The use of District buildings or grounds shall not be used for soliciting PPS students by organizations or individuals unless approved by the District.
- (b) District employees may not solicit of funds, distribute literature or conduct other activities for political purposes while on duty.
- (2) Illegal and Unlawful Activities.
- (3) Alcohol, Tobacco, or Illegal Drugs.
- (4) <u>Gambling.</u> Gambling of any sort, including bingo, games of chance, and raffles shall be prohibited in school buildings.
- (5) <u>Motorized Equipment and Horses.</u> The operation of drones, helicopters, mini-bikes, motorized airplanes and similar motorized recreational equipment; horseback/pony riding.
- (6) <u>Rocket Propulsion Devices/Fireworks.</u> The use of rockets and similar jet propulsion devices, unless the use of such devices is for instructional projects and under staff supervision; all fireworks are prohibited.
- (7) Advertising or Sale of Merchandise. The advertising or sale of merchandise in the building or on the school grounds by non-students shall not be permitted except with the consent of the administrator; provided that this shall not apply to merchandise which is the product of the student of any school and where such product is advertised and sold by students with the approval of the school administrator. The Office of the Superintendent may authorize the sale in school of certain articles if determined to be essential to the successful operation of the educational program.
 - (a) Recycling projects are permitted on school grounds on designated days under supervision of school-sponsored groups (PTAs/PTOs, Parent's Club, etc.) or community schools. Dump boxes may not be placed on school grounds. Collected material cannot remain on school grounds unless secured. Sales of used clothing are not permitted.
