The birth or adoption of a child;


A serious illness (your own or that of a

harassment, or stalking).



How to code this in Time and Labor for Attendance keying

For <u>Hourly employees</u> you do not need to worry about entering the Paid Leave OR (Unpaid) code since hourly people are only paid when time worked so you have no pay to reduce when no hours are entered. Standard will pay their benefit, and if the employees selects top off you will enter the leave time as guided by the Leave Dept in the email they send.
