 - o MPC suggestion/recommendation about using the ed specs to build partnerships for Benson



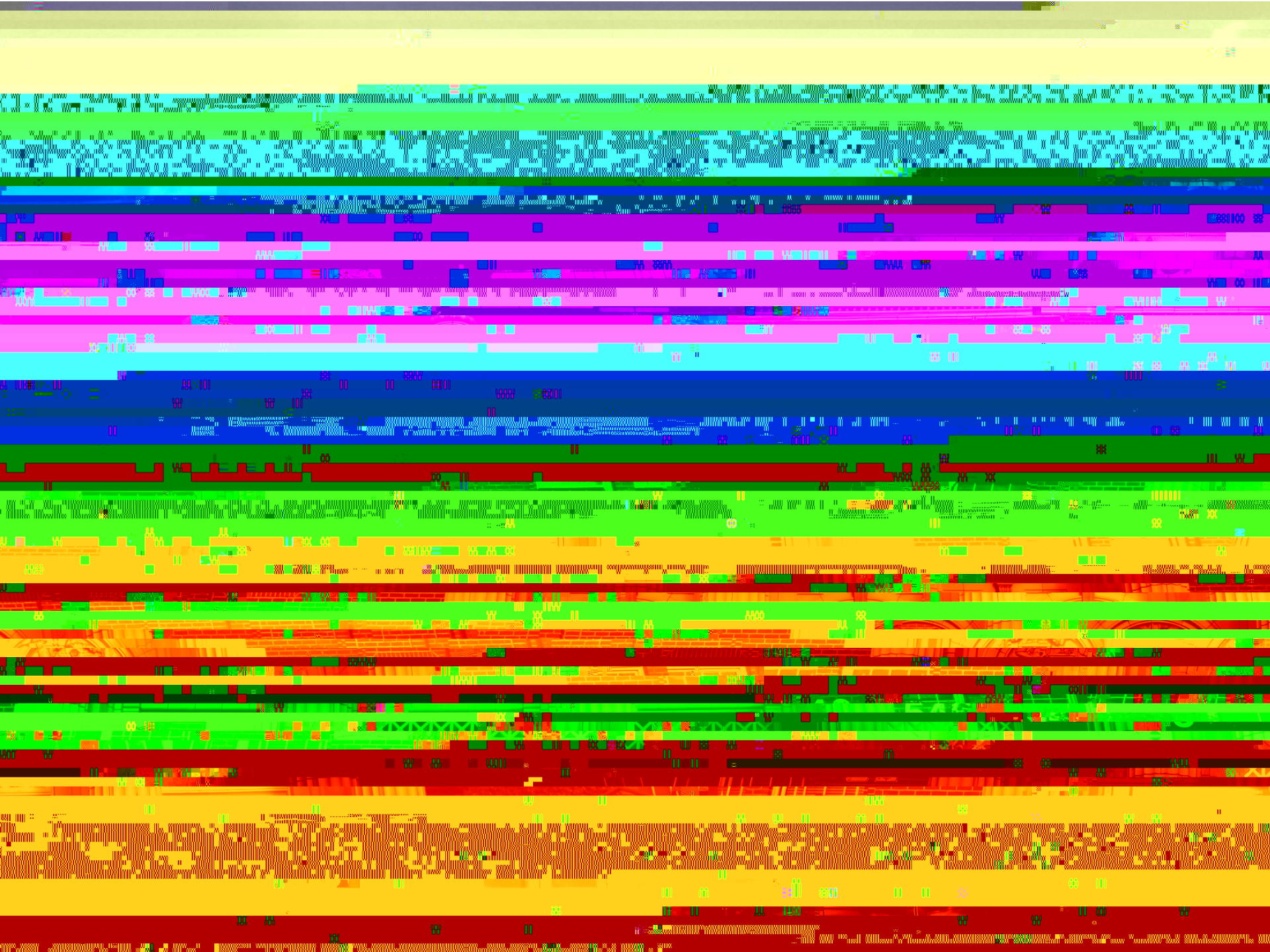
- x Subcommittees broken into the academies.
